P.A. 99-0642 Review

Mr. Walsh made the trustees aware of Public Act 99-0642, which was passed on August 25, 2015 and will become effective on January 1, 2016. The main objective of the law is to increase the use of MWDE firms for various professional service providers to public pension funds.

2016 Meeting Dates and Office Holidays

Mr. Walsh reviewed the proposed 2016 Board Meeting and Office Holiday Observance schedules with trustees. The trustees discussed their availability and scheduling conflicts.

<u>Miscellaneous: Trustee Education Summaries</u> – Mr. Walsh provided trustees with a summary of their year-to-date Ethics education hours.

<u>2015 Minority Investment Hearings</u> – Mr. Walsh reminded the trustees that the LABF will be presenting at the hearings on November 18 and 19, 2015. The Committee is encouraging trustees to attend the hearings.

<u>2015 Trustee Election</u> – Mr. Walsh introduced Trustee-Elect, James Joiner to the trustees. Mr. Walsh reported to the trustees that Mr. Joiner will be sworn in December 3rd. Mr. Joiner's three-year term as trustee will begin December 2, 2015.

<u>Trustee Appointments</u> – Mr. Walsh reminded the trustees that the terms of Trustees Hamburger and Brown expire on December 1, 2015. Mr. Walsh stated that he had not yet received notice of the names of the City appointees for the subsequent three-year terms.

<u>P.A. 98-0641</u> – Mr. Donham reported the status of the appeal for the Johnson v. LABF matter. Mr. Donham noted that the IL Supreme Court Hearing would be held on Tuesday, November 17, 2015.

<u>Dobbs Appeal</u> – Mr. Donham reported that the attorney for the adoptive mother of the children in the Dobbs matter, has filed an appeal of the Board's decision to deny Child Annuities. The trustees requested that Mr. Donham prepare a memo on this matter.

Mr. Donham updated the trustees on this matter and noted that a ruling will be made by December 15, 2015.
