## Health Insurance Plan Review – Pre Retirement Appointment

It is your responsibility to review your plan options for retiree health insurance.

The City of Chicago has a Benefits Service Center you should call to request health insurance information at **1-877-299-5111** and/or they have also set up a user friendly website for you to research your health insurance options: <http://chicagoretireebenefits.org>

If you access the above website you will need to be able to respond to the following basic questions:

1. Retiree Code:

- Please contact the City of Chicago if you don't know your years of City service
- If you have **20 or more years of City service** your retiree code is : **K**
- If you have between **15-19 years of City service** your retiree code is: **P**
- If you have between **10 – 14 years of City service** your retiree code is: **S**
- If you have less than **10 years of City service** your retiree code is: **V**

2. What Illinois County will you reside in after retirement?

3. Who will you cover on your retiree insurance (who did you cover on your active plan?)

4. Is anyone you are covering currently on Medicare part A?

**You must complete your research prior to your appointment with the Pension Fund.**
