Dear Chicago Public Schools Retiree,

Chicago Public Schools (CPS) will continue to offer retiree health insurance in 2018 for enrolled CPS annuitants who have a pension through the Municipal Employees' Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago (MEABF) or the Laborers' Annuity and Benefit Fund (LABF). This plan will continue to provide the same quality medical and prescription drug benefits that you are accustomed to. These benefits include a PPO medical plan that provides competitive inpatient and outpatient coverage as well as retail and mail-order prescription drug coverage. In the year ahead, there are no increases in co-pays, co-insurance, or deductibles.

There will be a change in your monthly premium. The chart below shows the decrease in your health premiums beginning January 1, 2018:
