

NOTICE OF AN ELECTION FOR ONE TRUSTEE FOR A TERM OF DECEMBER 2, 2021 – DECEMBER 1, 2024



Laborers' and Retirement Board Employees' Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago

In accordance with State law, an election must be held to select a board trustee of the Laborers' and Retirement Board Employees' Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago ("LABF") representing the active employees to serve a three-year term beginning December 2, 2021 and ending December 1, 2024.

The Board of Trustees of the LABF ("Board") hereby gives notice that the election will be held on **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2021** between the hours of **9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.** at the following locations:

The election will be by ballot and will be conducted in accordance with the rules established by the Board as required by law. All active employee participants of the LABF as of the date of the election are eligible to vote in this election.

Any eligible employee member of the LABF who desires to become a candidate for trustee in this election must submit a Petition Application in person at the LABF office during the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday – Friday no later than 3:00 p.m. on August 19, 2021. Petition Applications are available beginning August 2 and can be obtained (1) by downloading it from the LABF website at LABFchicago.org, (2) by email (call 312-236-2065 to request), or (3) in person at the LABF office.

Once the Petition Application is received, candidacy eligibility will be verified and a Nominating Petition will be provided to the eligible employee. Nominating Petitions must be submitted in person to the LABF office no later than 3:00 p.m. on August 20, 2021.
