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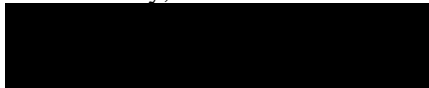

INVESTMENTS REPORT

The Investments Report was taken out of order.

Market Tracker Report

Mr. Obed provided a summary market update.

June 30, 2019 Preliminary Performance Report

Mr. Obed reviewed the Fund's June 30, 2019 Preliminary Performance Report and gave an overview of some of the Fund's investment strategies.

Private Equity Update

Mr. Wesner provided an overview of the private equity (PE) market. Mr. Wesner informed the Trustees that the PE market continues to provide a relatively attractive investment opportunity for institutional investors and that, in order to adhere to its pacing plan, LABF must continue to make new commitments every 12 to 18 months.

James Wesner, Kweku Obed and Neil Capps left the meeting.

Introductions

President Roa introduced Reshma Soni, the Acting City Comptroller for the City of Chicago, to the Board. Mr. Walsh introduced the Trustees, Staff and Consultants to Ms. Soni.

Election of Board Vice-President

This item was taken out of order. Mr. Walsh and Mr. Burns discussed an issue regarding the Illinois Pension Code's requirements for filling vacant appointed positions on the Board. The Trustees agreed the issue should be reviewed by Corporation Counsel for the City of Chicago. The Board also decided to defer the election of a Board Vice-President until a future meeting.

ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING - TREADWELL

Pursuant to the March 25, 2019 Order issued by the Circuit Court of Cook County, an administrative hearing was held to determine how to distribute the employee contributions made to the Laborers' and Retirement Board Employees' Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago ("LABF") by Alphonso Treadwell Sr. ("Alphonso"), a deceased member of the LABF.

Victor Roa, Board President, presided over the hearing. Joseph Burns and Taylor Muzzy, Fund Counsel, represented the LABF. Alphonso's ex-spouse, Yvonne Treadwell was present and was represented by Neil Kauffman. Four of Alphonso and Yvonne's five children were present: Tameka Esco, represented by Ralanda Webb, Alphonso Treadwell Jr., Dedra Treadwell, and Lakisha Esco. The hearing was transcribed by a court reporter.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the trustees decided to enter executive session pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(4) and (11).

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EXECUTIVE SESSION NO. 1

At 4:21 p.m., Trustee LoVerde requested an executive session under 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(4) to discuss considering evidence/testimony presented in an open/closed hearing and under 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(11) to discuss pending or probable litigation against, affecting, or on behalf of the Fund. Trustee Hamburger seconded the motion.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

Tier 3 Normal Cost Calculation

Mr. Walsh reported that AON determined that the Tier 3 normal cost as a percentage of pay is 17.34% for 2019, based on the December 31, 2018 valuation data. Therefore, the contribution rate for Tier 3 employees will remain 11½% for the year 2020. Trustee Hamburger requested a copy of the results be sent to the City of Chicago.

Pre-Approval of Reciprocal Conference

Mr. Walsh reported that the 2019 Reciprocal Conference will be held in Champaign, Illinois on August 12 and 13, 2019 and informed that Board that up to five staff members might attend the conference.

Legislative Matters

Mr. Walsh reported that Senate Bill 1264 and House Bill 2460 were sent to the Governor on June 28, 2019 and June 27, 2019, respectively, and have yet to be signed by the Governor.

Miscellaneous

This item was not discussed.

Public Act 100-0023 Employer Contribution Mechanics

Mr. Walsh briefed the Board regarding a meeting he had with representatives from the City of Chicago regarding contributions associated with those taking a leave of absence from the City of Chicago to work for a local labor organization. Further discussion was deferred to a future Board meeting.

LEGAL REPORT

Underwood Litigation

Mr. Walsh updated the Board regarding the actions taken at the September 15, 2019 hearing in the Circuit Court of Cook County regarding the Underwood litigation. Mr. Walsh also updated the Board on the mechanics of the court order issued related to the notices that are to be sent to retiree members of LABF who may be eligible for the retiree healthcare subsidy.

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Boutte v. LABF

Mr. Muzzy updated the Board regarding the proceedings in the Boutte litigation and noted that the next court date is September 10, 2019.

Payne Matter

Mr. Muzzy gave an overview of the Payne bankruptcy matter in which Mr. Payne received an overpayment from the LABF that the Fund is seeking to recoup.

ADJOURNMENT

With no further business, at 4:45 p.m., Trustee Capasso made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Trustee LoVerde seconded the motion.
